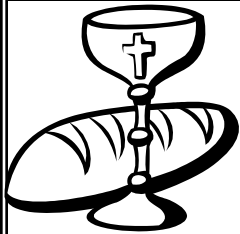


WORSHIP MINISTRY

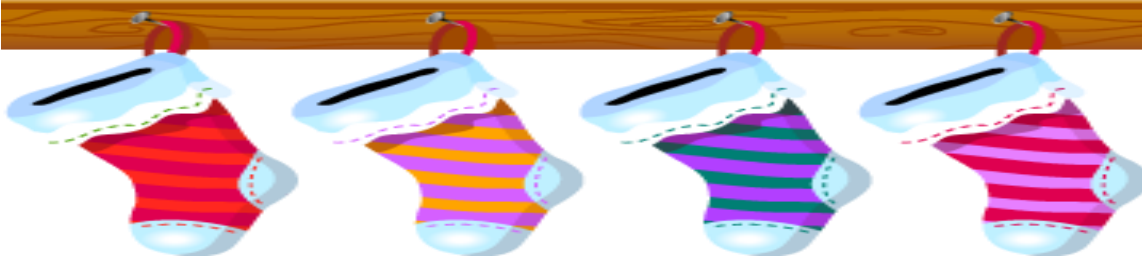
Stewardship Pledge Cards and Commitment Sheets were collected at Sunday's service. If you did not turn yours in, please drop them by the office at your first opportunity.

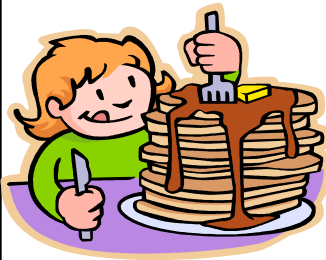
