BACKPACK FOR KIDS

Nearly 1 in 5 children in our area live in extreme poverty and thus are at high risk of hunger. In partnership with the Tarrant Area Food Bank, the Community Caring Center provides children at local schools with backpacks full of healthy, kid-friendly food each Friday to last through the weekend. For kids who depend on their school's free or reduced-priced meal program, the food they receive might be all they get between lunch on Friday and breakfast on Monday.

SWAN VIEW THERAPEUTIC HORSEBACK RIDING CENTER

Located north of Azle, the Center is dedicated to improving the quality of life for individuals with disabilities by providing therapeutic riding activities for their special needs. Horseback riding for the handicapped through the movement of a horse has physical benefits to balance, flexibility, agility and strength. Interaction of rider, horse, instructor and volunteers has social and self-confidence benefits.

SPRINGTOWN NEIGHBOR TO NEIGHBORS and CASTLE HILLS MISSION HOUSE

Helping to meet the needs of their communities by providing food and clothes, some furniture, personal hygiene items, school supplies, and some utility assistance. Both of these organizations provide a helping hand to those with immediate needs, while also providing assistance to help people become self sufficient.

"IN AS MUCH" EAGLE MOUNTAIN FOOD PANTRY

Food is provided to individuals in need, many living in an area north of Azle. Started in 2006, the pantry has grown to feeding over 200 people each week.

WEEK OF COMPASSION DISASTER RELIEF

AZLE HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

A non-denominational Christian housing ministry that welcomes all people regardless of race, religion, and ethnicity. Habitat will help to build simple, decent, affordable houses in the Azle area. Families qualify on the basis of need, willingness to partner with the Habitat program and ability to make mortgage payments that average between \$350-\$450 monthly, including taxes and insurance.

LIBERTY LIGHTHOUSE

A faith based ministry, offering shelter for women and children. A safe haven is provided where they can feel secure from the storms of life. Their stay allows them time for healing, education, and preparation for their future.

ROBERT LANDERS YOUTH GOLF ASSOCIATION

A program dedicated to the overall growth and development of young men and women. This program allows many to become involved who otherwise might not be financially able. Youngsters are invited to Cross Timbers Golf Course to learn under the watchful eyes of professionals.
